



All of BAR's courses are FAA approved. Content is drawn from information in the Aircraft Maintenance Technician Handbook (FAA-H-8083-30A), Chapter 2; from the Aviation Mechanic General, Airframe, and Powerplant – Airman Certification Standards (FAA-S-ACS-1); and ... from the real-world experience of BAR's team of aircraft maintenance professionals with a combined experience of over 200 years in business aircraft maintenance and operations.

Includes

- Aircraft Documents Specialist courses taught in full.
- Each student receives a USB with course content and videos to reference in the future.
- Certificate as an *Aircraft Documents Specialist* mailed to each student within a couple of weeks of completing the classroom event.
- Classroom participation is required and encouraged.
- Testing on each course is accomplished as a group in the classroom using the reference materials sited with each test.
- Classroom learning involves 2 days of instruction – approximately 6 to 8 hours each day including breaks between sessions and a full one-hour lunch.
